### About the role

We established the Go Green project back in 2018, focusing on helping students better understand the climate emergency and delivering practical opportunities for students to reduce waste, save energy & save money in an environmentally friendly way.

We're looking for 4 enthusiastic students to help us run our activities across our campuses, including the running and upkeep of the Go Green Hubs in each campus reception area. These Hubs are primarily used to house our community fridges and clothing swap shops, offering items that might have otherwise ended up in landfill to students for free.

Hours will be mostly flexible around your timetable, but must include a fixed time for a weekly delivery of food for each campus.

### Responsibilities include:

- Taking delivery of food for Community Fridge on a weekly basis
- Maintaining records for fridge and removing items that are no longer edible
- Weighing and recording of donations for swap shop
- Maintaining and rotating stock items
- General upkeep of Go Green hubs
- Working with relevant College teams to promote active travel for students
- General promotion of the project and gathering feedback from students

Full training will be provided to ensure we remain compliant with all health & safety and food hygiene requirements.
