About the role

The College and EC Students' Association are working in partnership on a project designed to engage with, and welcome, students from a sanctuary-seeking background.

Although there is already a lot of work happening across the College for the over 1000 students from a sanctuary-seeking background, we are working to improve all aspects of our processes and services in order to obtain the nationally recognised "Colleges of Sanctuary" accreditation.

This role will work with the College of Sanctuary Steering Group to ensure that the student voice is heard within the process and the outcomes are reflective of student needs.

Responsibilities include:

- Helping to promote the project to EC students in order to educate all students about the challenges faced by students from sanctuary-seeking backgrounds
- Engaging with EC students from sanctuary-seeking backgrounds to gather their experiences, and help them voice their needs and wants from the College
- Organising opportunities for students to engage in the work of the group, including focus groups, drop-ins, etc.
- Gathering evidence of the work conducted across the College in supporting students from sanctuary-seeking backgrounds
- Reporting back to the Steering Group, contributing to the final submission

Training on systems and processes as well as and one-to-one supervision & support will be provided for the role. The role will work alongside the EC Students' Association team ensuring the College of Sanctuary project involves and is embedded in all aspects of our student engagement activities.
